## Accessing Coquitlam Public Library Databases

Coquitlam Public Library subscribes to thousands of electronic newspaper and magazine articles. We also have online audiobooks, e-books, car repair manuals and encyclopedias. These are found in databases that can be accessed in the library or, in many cases, from home.

All you need is access to the **internet** and an up-to-date **Coquitlam Public Library card**.

### How to find our databases:

#### In library:

Sign on to a public internet station at either branch. On the desktop screen choose:



This will take you directly to our database page.

From home or work:

Click on: **Articles, Newspapers, Encyclopedias...**



At the login screen, enter the **barcode numbers** on the back of your Coquitlam Public Library card and your **password**—usually the last four digits of your telephone number—and then click **“Go”**.

You will then see a list of databases under various headings. Simply click on a title to open up the database and begin searching.
