by *Vivian French*

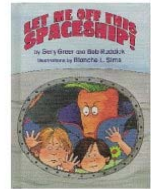

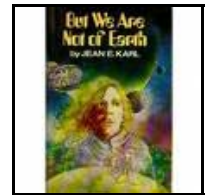


J KAR

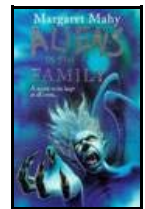


J MAH

The mismatched children in a new step-family run into an alien. He is being chased around the galaxy by an evil force. Funny, scary and touching with plenty of action.

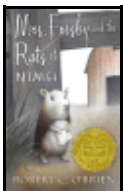


J OBR
